<b>FEDERATIONS INVITED</b>	<p>The Organizing Member Federation will invite all Member Federations according to the following principles:</p> <p>Gymnasts from the FIG affiliated federations and/or their clubs in good standing, except from countries not allowed by the FIG exceptional measures, may participate. The clubs have to respect their national eligibility rules for participation in the international events.</p>
<b>AGE LIMITS</b>	<p><b>A. FIG sanctioned - men &amp; women, boys &amp; girls:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- <b>Senior individual</b> - 17 years and older (born 2005 and before)</li> <li>-- <b>Junior individual</b> - 11-12, 13-14, 15-16 years (born 2006-2007)</li> </ul> <p><b>B. - Remarks :</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Difficulty limit per element in junior category as per valid FIG Code of Points.</li> </ul> <p><b>All gymnasts must have a valid FIG licence until the end of the event. Gymnasts without the FIG licence will be not allowed to start.</b> (senior gymnasts, junior individual 11-12, 13-14, 15-16, and junior synchro gymnasts 13-16)</p> <p><b>B. FIG not sanctioned:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>A. Senior synchro</b> - 17 years and older (born 2005 and before)</li> <li><b>Junior synchro</b> - 13-16 years (born 2006-2009)</li> <li>Youth synchro - 11-13?</li> </ul>

<b>JUDGES AND JURIES</b>	<p><b>All judges must have a current valid FIG brevet at the time of the event, for the respective discipline (TRA).</b></p> <p>All participating delegations have to provide 1 judge.</p>
<b>REGISTRATION DEADLINES</b>	<p>The nominative registration must be made exclusively online via the GymCity Open website <a href="http://www.gymcity-open.de">www.gymcity-open.de</a>. It is possible to register from the 15<sup>th</sup> of March 2023. All members of the delegation that attend the competition (athletes, coaches, judges) have to be registered.</p> <p>Nominative registration <b>1<sup>st</sup> May 2023</b></p> <p>Penalty for missing judge or late registration <b>35€</b> per participant of the team.</p> <p>All additional services such as accommodation, banquet and transfer service can be booked by the nominative registration. All coming delegation will be informed through an email.</p>
<b>ENTRY FEES</b>	<p>The entry fee for this event will be <b>35€</b> per person and <b>35€</b> for each synchronized pair.</p> <p>Entry fees are non-refundable in case of cancellation.</p>
<b>ACCREDITATION</b>	<p>The accreditation is on Friday 26<sup>th</sup> May 2023 at 04.00pm in the local organisation office. Heads of the delegations are required to bring the following documents:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Passport/any ID of all members of the delegation</li> <li>- Proof of total payments</li> <li>- Proof of medical insurances</li> <li>- International/national judge licenses</li> </ul>
<b>EVENT FORMAT</b>	<p>Eight (8) finalists (6 finalists if 7 – 8 participants, 4 finalists if 5 – 6 participants, 3 finalists if 3 – 4 participants in category). Finals will start from zero. Tie-breaking rules as per FIG Code of Points.</p> <p>In addition, the host Club SC Cottbus Turnen e.V. is allowed to set up one gymnast per category in every final. If there is no athlete from home club in the final there will be nine (9) starters in the final (Cottbus club Wildcard).</p> <p>In competition there will be no “one- touch” instead every category becomes 20 minutes of warming up. In the finals there will be 10 minutes warming up time.</p>

<b>MEDICAL SERVICES</b>	The medical care will be provided by the organizing committee. The guarantee includes the first aid as well as transportation by ambulance to the nearby hospital. A paramedic ambulance will be on site during official training, warm up and competition periods.
<b>INSURANCE</b>	The Host Federation, the Organizing Committee will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation and the like. The FIG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating Federations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their Delegation.  The LOC will verify the insurance upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy). Delegation members with insufficient insurance cover must inform the LOC in advance.
<b>LOCAL TRANSPORTATION</b>	The local transportation from the airports (Berlin, Dresden) or railway station and between the hotel and venue will cost 50€ (per delegation member) and must be ordered.
<b>COVID-19</b>	All Federations / clubs are invited to take information about special requirements and restrictions to enter Germany for their respective countries. In due time the LOC will provide all participating delegations a detailed Covid-19 guidelines.  FIG requires all participants, judges and officials to take standard precautionary measures, such as washing their hands and using a mask at all times and, when possible, to keep a physical distance of at least 1.5 meters.  The only situation in which it is possible that the safety distance may not be respected is when the coach assists the gymnast during their performances (catching, directing, guarding). This phase should be as short as possible and the person assisting is obliged to use a mask during this time

<b>ADDITIONAL INFORMATION</b>	<p><b>Age Group Competition (not sanctioned)</b></p> <p>individual (TRI) &amp; Synchro (TRS):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- <b>girls AG</b> 11-12 years (born 2010-2011), 13-14 years (born 2008-2009)</li> <li>- <b>boys AG</b> 11-12 years (born 2010-2011), 13-14 years (born 2008-2009)</li> </ul> <p>Remarks:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- In synchronised competition, the age of the older gymnast determines the category in which the pair must enter.</li> <li>- In synchronised competitions, the 13-14 gymnasts can compete EITHER in AG 13-14 synchro category (FIG not sanctioned) OR in Junior 13-16 synchro category (FIG sanctioned and FIG licence is compulsory) ONLY.</li> <li>- Requirements for first routine as per FIG Junior and WAGC Rules (FIG 11-12, 13-14), no first routine in synchro</li> <li>- Difficulty limit per element in AG 11-12 &amp; 13-14 category as per valid FIG Junior and WAGC Rules.</li> </ul> <p>For Age Group Competition only:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- FIG licence is recommended for the gymnasts. Delegations have to prove the age of the gymnasts (FIG licence, national licence, passport, personal ID, insurance, etc.), if requested by LOC.</li> <li>- If 5 or less participants/pairs in the category, no qualification will be held (final only). If 3 or less participants/pairs in the category, the category may be joined to another category or cancelled.</li> <li>- Also national judges with highest national category may be accepted. The LOC may require the proof of the national judging brevet or ask respective NF for confirmation the national category.</li> </ul>
